



3-Day Texas Wine Country Itinerary from Austin



Day 1 – Austin → Fredericksburg

Driving Time: ~1 hour 45 minutes

Morning: Depart Austin

- Leave Austin early to maximize tasting time
- Stop in Fredericksburg for breakfast, shopping, and historic charm

Midday: Fredericksburg Wineries

Becker Vineyards

- Known for award-winning wines and lavender fields
- Relaxed tasting room with outdoor seating

Grape Creek Vineyards

- Tuscan-style estate with vineyard views
- Great spot for photos and relaxed tastings

Afternoon

- Explore downtown Fredericksburg boutiques and German-inspired shops
- Optional lunch or wine bar stop in town

Evening

- Dinner in Fredericksburg
- Overnight in Fredericksburg or nearby Stonewall

Day 2 – Stonewall → Johnson City

Driving Time: ~30–40 minutes total

Morning: Stonewall Wineries

Texas Hills Vineyard

- One of the oldest wineries in the area
- Friendly tastings with Texas wine education

Additional Stonewall Stops (Optional)

- Scenic drives along Highway 290
- Casual vineyard hopping at your own pace

Lunch

- Lunch near Stonewall or Johnson City
- Enjoy a relaxed midday break before more tastings

Afternoon: Johnson City

Fall Creek Vineyards

- One of the pioneers of Texas wine
- Elevated tasting experience with a broad wine selection

Evening

- Dinner in Johnson City or return toward Fredericksburg
- Overnight near Johnson City or Driftwood for Day 3 convenience

Day 3 – Driftwood → Dripping Springs → Austin

Driving Time: ~1 hour total

Morning: Driftwood

Salt Lick Cellars

- Winery adjacent to the famous Salt Lick BBQ
- Casual atmosphere and Hill Country views

Afternoon: Dripping Springs

- Explore the charming town known as the “Gateway to the Hill Country”
- Optional distillery or brewery stop (if desired)

Lunch

- Salt Lick BBQ (if you want a classic Texas experience)
- Or grab lunch in Driftwood or Dripping Springs

Evening: Return to Austin

- Easy drive back to Austin
- Perfect end to a long weekend wine getaway
